IMPORTANT ENTRY INFORMATION:

Owners of all Pure-bred Irish Draught horses in affiliated In-hand & Ridden classes must be full members of the IDHS(GB). This rule does not apply to owners of Irish Draught Sport horses.

1. Classes 1 – 12 & 17 - 18 are affiliated to the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) and only horses registered with or overstamped by the IDHS (GB) and in the correct ownership are eligible for entry.
All Pure Bred Breeding and Youngstock In-hand exhibits must be the progeny of a Graded Mare (ID Class1, Class 2, RID, AID or Supplementary Grade Up Register) and be by a Class 1, Class 2 or RID (GB) stallion on the Irish Draught Breed Register.
All Sport Horses must be registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Register.

All competing STALLIONS must be the progeny of a Graded Mare (ID Class1, Class2, RID, AID or Supplementary Grade Up Register) by a Class 1 Class 2 or RID (GB) stallion and be inspected or overstamped by the IDHS (GB) and classified as RID (GB), ID Class 1 or ID Class 2 OR be a Registered Irish Draught Sport Horse Stallion, and they must display a red, white and blue ribbon in their tails. All riders of STALLIONS must be 18 years of age or over.

All in-hand stallions and 1, 2 and 3 year old colts must be bitted and shown by an experienced handler of 18 years or over. **All ridden horses must be 153cm (15hh) or over.**

Registration numbers to be stated on the entry form and entries will be sent to the IDHS (GB) prior to the Show to confirm eligibility.

2. Competitors may enter more than one class but the Show Committee will not be responsible if clashes occur
3. All ridden horses must be 4 years and over, exceed 148cm (approx 14.2hh) and for all affiliated classes must be registered in the IDHS studbook or the IDSH register.

*** On The Day entries for affiliated IDHS (GB) classes: If you enter on the day for these classes you MUST bring your horse's passport for us to check it is registered and eligible for the class.**

- Entry forms must be fully completed and the correct entry fees (including First Aid Fee) enclosed to be eligible for entry to the appropriate classes. No entries accepted without the appropriate First Aid fee
- No entry fee refunds except for cancellation of the Show or a Class by the Show Team
- All competitor numbers to be collected on the day. (* See note below)

PRIZE MONEY:

Classes: Less than 6 entries – awarded to 1st & 2nd places only. Less than 4 entries –awarded to 1st place only.
1st - £15 2nd - £10 3rd - £5

Championships: Champion £50 plus prize Reserve Champion £25

All classes have perpetual trophies

*** Equine Flu:** Horses must be up to date with their annual vaccination booster or they need to have their second vaccination 7 days prior to the show.

Remember in line with DEFRA regulations, passports should always be carried and available to be checked.

Passports will be checked at the show when you collect your back number.

IDHS (GB) AFFILIATED QUALIFIERS:

Q1 - Blue Chip & Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) £2,000 Challenge.

The highest placed horse with a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding and not already qualified from **Classes 15, 16, 17 & 18** will qualify for the Final of the Blue Chip & IDHS (GB) £2,000 Challenge which will be held at the IDHS (GB) Annual Breed Show 17th – 18th August 2019 at Arena UK, Allington, Grantham, Lincolnshire. NG32 2EF.

N.B: A horse may only qualify for the Final once, regardless of the type or number of classes won, placed in or entered. Each qualifier will receive a card and a £10 voucher from Blue Chip. *Qualifiers are required to complete an online form at www.idhsqb.com to inform the IDHS (GB) that they have qualified for the Final.*

In the Final, the Champion will be awarded £1,000 prize money, a trophy and a Blue Chip rug. The Reserve Champion will be awarded £500 and 3rd to 7th inclusive will be awarded £100 each. In addition, the highest placed Pure Bred Irish Draught will receive a trophy and £100, the highest placed 158cm (15.2hh) and under will receive a trophy and £50, the highest placed Sport Horse will receive a trophy and £50, and the highest placed *Amateur Produced and Ridden Horse will receive £50, a silver salver and a rug.

Q2 - The Moorbennhall Irish Draught Youngstock Challenge.

The two highest placed **Pure Breeds** from each age group that have not already qualified in Classes **7, 8 & 9** (yearlings, two year olds and three year olds) - eligible for Class 1 on the Irish Draught Breed Register by an ID Class 1, ID Class 2 or RID (GB) sire out of a Graded* dam will qualify to go forward to the Final which will be held at the IDHS (GB) Annual Breed Show on 17th and 18th August 2019 at Arena UK, Allington, Grantham Lincolnshire. NG32 2EF. Each qualifier will receive a card. *Qualifiers are required to complete an online form www.idhsqb.com to inform the IDHS (GB) that they have qualified for the Final.* In the Final, there will be three preliminary classes with the two highest placed semi-finalists from each class going forward to the Championship where the Champion will receive **£500** and the Reserve Champion **£150**.

GENERAL RULES:

- 1 AGE OF RIDER/HANDLER. No rider/handler under sixteen years of age on the day of the show is eligible to compete in any classes. (Riders & handlers of colts and stallions MUST be 18) Proof of age may be required.**
- The Judge's decision is final. Any objections must be made in writing to the Show Secretary within 30 minutes of the completion of the class with a £50 cash deposit which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld.
- The Show Committee reserves the right to rearrange times, amalgamate or cancel classes and adjust prizes money accordingly. They also reserve the sole right to interpret rules and conditions and to finally settle and determine all or any matter, question or difference arising from Show policy.
- The Show Committee accepts no responsibility for accidents to spectators, competitors, animals or their property in connection with or arising from the show. Admission is granted and entries accepted only on recognition of this condition. The IDHS (GB) accepts no responsibility for any injury arising from failure to comply with these show rules.
- Bitless bridles, running gags, market harboroughs, side, draw or running reins are not allowed in any class. The use of Swales, Sam Marsh bits and gags with double bridles are actively discouraged. Boots and martingales are not permitted in any flat ridden class.
- No tack which conceals an animal's conformation or identifies an animal, its owner or sponsor is allowed in any ring.
- It is the sole responsibility of all riders to ensure that whilst mounted, they wear appropriate clothing and footwear and a correctly fitted riding hat which complies with the minimum current European standards.
- All handlers and Grooms are also advised to wear a properly fitted hard hat or skull cap to current European standards whilst leading or working any horse inside or outside the ring.
- If in the judges/stewards opinion any horse is regarded to compromise the safety of other competitors or spectators, they will be asked to leave the ring.
- A fall of horse or rider in any ridden class will lead to elimination from the class.
- Parents/carers of children and young people under the age of 16 years are responsible for their supervision at all times whilst at the Show. No prams or pushchairs are allowed in the arenas.
- Dogs are allowed in the outdoor areas of the Show but **MUST** be on a short lead at all times. (No flexi or extending leads in the vicinity of any horse, ring, box, car park or stable areas) Owners must clean up all mess after their pets.
- No Smoking in the International Arena or near stables

CLASS 4 ID SPORT HORSE BROOD MARE. (In foal or with own foal at foot) 4 yrs & over registered on the ID Sport Horse Register, or SID

All 1, 2 and 3 year old COLTS must be bitted and shown by an experienced handler of 18 years of age or over

CLASS 7 (Q2) YEARLING COLT, FILLY or GELDING by an RID (GB) or ID Class 1 or Class 2 sire, out of a *graded mare

CLASS 8 (Q2) 2 YEAR OLD COLT, FILLY or GELDING by an RID (GB) or ID Class 1 or Class 2 sire, out of a *graded mare

CLASS 9 (Q2) 3 YEAR OLD UNINSPECTED COLT, FILLY or GELDING by an RID (GB) or ID Class 1 or Class 2 sire, out of a *graded mare

CLASS 10 IRISH DRAUGHT BROOD MARES. *Graded mares, 3 yrs & over with own foal at foot

Free walk: Trot serpentine; Canter on both reins; Halt & Rein back
- Jumping: 30 marks

*At least 3 fences (one designated fence to be taken at trot) max height 76cm (2ft 6 in)
If a horse has 3 refusals during the jumping phase the combination will be eliminated*

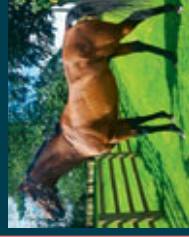

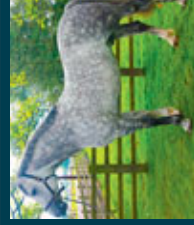
